Willis and Glass both pitched masterful ball. The Red Sox were unable to find Willis. Until the ninth inning they got only one hit. In that frame Dials tapped one for four bases. Lefty Williams then took the mound for the Elites. He was wild and allowed two walks and the winning run in the 11th. Jessie Edwards and Charles Blackwell displayed a flashy brand of fielding and on several occasions robbed the Red Sox of hits that would have meant runs for the Red Sox. Carter Glass, veteran Memphis pitching ace, allowed Tom Wilson's clan 14 hits, but he kept cool at all times.
